1st Quarter

Boarders return Tuesday 16 January
School begins Wednesday 17 January
Free weekend Wed 14 February to Mon 19
Term ends Thursday 22 March
(Easter: Friday 30 March – Monday 2 April)

2nd Quarter

Boarders return Tuesday 17 April
School begins Wed 18 April
Free weekend Wed 16 May to Monday 21
Term ends Thursday 21 June

3rd Quarter

Boarders return Monday 16 July
School begins Tuesday 17 July
Free weekend Wed 15 August to Monday 20
Term ends Thursday 20 September

4th Quarter

Boarders return Tuesday 2 October
Term begins Wednesday 3 October
Free weekend Wed 31 October to Monday 5 November
Term ends Saturday 01 December. Children may be
collected at 2pm on break-up days.
Boarders return before 6pm.

Please bear in mind the following points:

1. Your children should arrive at school with the complete uniform, including all footwear, sports equipment and bedding **properly marked** (name tags sewn in).
2. Each child, from Grade 4 upward should be given an English dictionary, a Zulu/Afrikaans/English dictionary and an atlas.
3. **Stationery to be provided by you:** Calculator – Grades 4 to 6; Grade 7s require a “scientific” calculator. Scissors, koki pens, crayons and Pritt glue. A set of Mathematical Instruments (Gr 5 – 7)
4. Children travelling to either Johannesburg or Durban by Greyhound bus should be booked **well in advance of the date**, and their tickets sent to the school, or the ticket numbers faxed or emailed to the school.
5. Full time boarders may not go out for weekends immediately before and after a free weekend, nor for the first and last weekend of term.
6. Boarders must return **before** 6pm from holidays and from free weekends.
7. Pocket money is **not** permitted, except for use on special outings, in which case the money must be deposited at the office. Any money found in the children’s possession will be filed for them. Anything extraordinary the children might need will be bought by the school and the amount invoiced to your account.

8. You may phone your child on 033 266 6716 between 5:45pm and 6:30pm daily. Cellphones are not permitted.

9. The following items of tuck, **and only the following**, are permitted: processed cheese wedges, cracker biscuits and Pro-Vita biscuits, rusks, biltong, dried fruit, nuts, fresh fruit and fruit juices. (Sweets, chips, sweet biscuits, fizzy and artificial cooldrinks are not allowed.) **Please supply a lockable tuck box for this.**

10. Sports Equipment – Grades 1 to 7. In the first and the fourth quarters, WHITE takkies are required. When buying a cricket bat (which must be between 50% and 55% of your child’s weight) we urge you to consult a reputable sports dealer. Please supply, also, a tennis racquet. In the second and third quarters soccer/rugby boots are required, and a hockey stick (which should reach only as high as the hip bone from the ground).

11. We are unable to obtain insurance against loss of or damage to pupils’ property. You are advised to arrange for this yourselves.
